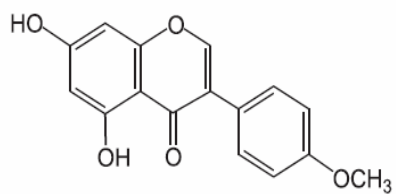

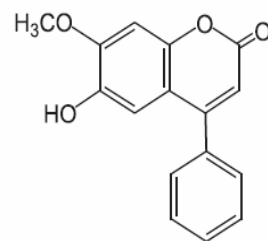

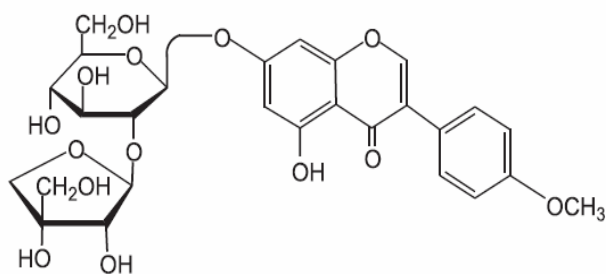
Major Bioactive Phytoconstituents of *Dalbergia* Species



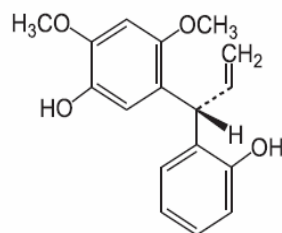
